Activity Bus Rules

- 1. All School conduct rules apply and will be enforced.
- 2. Passengers shall be courteous to the driver, to fellow passengers and to passers-by.
- 3. On this bus, you are under the authority of the driver. The driver may assign seats.
- 4. Passengers who refuse to obey promptly the directions of the driver, or refuse to obey regulations may forfeit their privilege to ride the bus.
- 5. No one is allowed inside bus or in luggage area without driver present.
- 6. Cleats and spikes are not allowed to be worn on bus, keep them properly stored.
- 7. Stay away from moving buses. Never chase for a bus; on foot or in a vehicle.
- 8. All passengers shall remain seated at all times in a forward facing position. Limit restroom use to emergency only. The aisle must be clear at all times.
- 9. Matches, lighters, lasers, toy/replica guns, firearms/weapons, or any other potentially hazardous material, including spray type or aerosol are prohibited.
- 10.Passengers shall converse in normal tones; loud or vulgar language or obscene gesturing is prohibited.
- 11. Fighting, wrestling or boisterous activity is prohibited on the bus. Passengers must keep hands and feet to themselves.
- 12.Eating and drinking on our activity buses is discouraged, and you may do so only with the Driver and Coaches/Teachers/Chaperones agreed permission. The following rules apply: Plastic drink containers with screw on tops only-No glass or fountain drinks, No sunflower or pistachio seeds, no popcorn, no un-shelled peanuts, no suckers, no milk products, no nachos or hot dogs. Driver may refuse any and all food or drink aboard at his or her discretion.
- 13. Passengers shall not throw objects into, from or on the bus.
- 14.Passengers shall keep the bus clean, put trash in trash cans; no one gets off until all trash is picked up.
- 15. Absolutely no horse-play! You will be held responsible for the damage you do to this bus, or the injury to others.
- 16.As a single passenger, you are expected to do your part in following these rules for the utmost safety for all on board.
